## Elmhurst St. Pat's Parade kicks off on March 8 at noon

### The parade location

Every year, the parade Marches off from Wilson Street and Spring Road heading north. ending at the railroad tracks south of St. Charles Road.

The best parade in Chicagoland, the Elmhurst St. Patrick's Day Parade, is expected again this year to attract a large crowd here in the western suburb of Elmhurst. Ample parking, security and planning will make for comfortable viewing conditions for all family members. The parade features floats, marching units and animated characters along with local organizations, businesses and clubs along a mile stretch. Don't miss your chance to see more than 80 floats, Irish Dancers,

the Shannon Rovers, local team mascots, Benny the Bull, Southpaw and Tommy Hawk. Also featured are the Chicago Highlanders, Medinah Clowns, York High School Marching Band and the Elmhurst Armpit Orchestra, displaying the world's largest drum.

The parade is only the beginning to this festive, day for the food, music and fun is sure to continue as Elmhurst merchants, restaurateurs and friends welcome visitors for this special community celebration.

## Parade Grand Marshal for 2025

### Elmhurst-Yorkfield Food Pantry

Elmhurst-Yorkfield Food Pantry (EYFP) is dedicated to providing food, compassion, and hope to our neighbors and children in need. EYFP began in 1983 out of a walk-in closet in the Yorkfield Presbyterian Church. Concerned church members sought to provide food assistance to struggling neighbors in the area. At that time, the pantry was able to serve about 25 families per week. As demand increased, so did the need for a new food pantry. EYFP opened the doors to its new 2,500 squarefoot facility on Janu-ary 2, 2016. The

ADA-compliant building offers clients a welcoming and dignified shopping environment.

EYFP is open during four shopping shifts per week, including evening and Saturday opportunities. Just like a grocery store, clients can choose the food items that match their family preferences. The pantry offers nutritious choices like meat, dairy, and produce, in addition to a large variety of non-perishable items, breads/ pastries, and personal care products.

In 2023, the EYFP fed more than 32,000 people, giving out nearly 250,000 pounds of produce, 10,000 gallons of milk, and 9,000 dozen eggs.


