2025 Lilac Time, Lilac Parade a success

This spring marks the 42nd consecutive year the Lombardian has published its Many Faces of Lombard and Villa Park section. Once again, this section coincides with the village's always popular Lilac Time and Lilac Parade held in May. In 2020 and 2021, the Many Faces section was published in the fall due to traditional Lilac Time activities being either curtailed or postponed because of ongoing concerns over the COVID-19 pandemic.

For the fourth consecutive year, Lilac Time's most anticipated event—the parade—took place May 18 without interference from either Mother Nature or a pandemic. The parade, a signature event in Lombard since 1936, was cancelled in 2019 due to the threat of severe weather the day of the parade. Then, of course, COVID-19 swept over the state and the nation in March, 2020. The 2021 parade had been scheduled for May 16, but the committee delayed it until Sept. 19 due to COVID concerns, hoping the situation surrounding COVID would improve. However, once again, the committee decided in August to cancel the parade for a second straight year due to public safety concerns and other factors such as reduced parade entries and participation.

2025 Lilac Queen

Marisa Olas was named Lombard's 2025 Lilac Queen during a coronation ceremony May 3, which took place at Lilacia Park. She is a senior at Glenbard East High School, where she is in the National, Rho Kappa and National English honor societies; was Ram of the Month, an Illinois State Scholar and an AP Scholar with Honor.

She has been involved in varsity badminton, JV golf, as a Senior Leader, FFA Link Crew, volleyball as a freshman and sophomore, theater cast (freshman year), costumes crew (freshman and sophomore year) and Scholastic Bowl (freshman year).

Outside of school, Queen Marisa has volunteered at the Helen Plum Library, Feed My Starving Children and Cantigny Lights; and is building flower boxes for Glenbard East's Dual Credit Horticulture and Urban Agriculture program.

She plans to attend the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign to major in history with a minor in secondary education. She aspires to become a high school history teacher.

Queen Marisa is the daughter of Shari and Tom Olas.

The final interviews to determine Lombard's 2025 Lilac Queen took place on Saturday, April 26, at the Westin Chicago Lombard, 70 Yorktown Center. During the interviews, each of the five princesses in this year's Lilac Court met separately with a panel of three judges who neither live nor work in Lombard. Those judges then decided which princess would be named this year's Lilac Queen.

Olive Turner, Khloe Hickman, Jillian Gorvett and Delaney Spontak join Queen Marisa as Lilac princesses and are members of the 2025 Lilac Court.

The members of this year's Lilac Court received their tiaras during a ceremony at the Maple Street Chapel March 12. The Lombard Junior Women's Club (LJWC) presented a tiara to each princess, along with a sash and flowers. Each member of this year's court briefly wore the original 1930 Lilac Queen crown during last week's event. The Lombard Service League provides the tiaras to the Lilac Court each year. The LJWC conducts the annual Lilac Princess Program, which dates back to 1930.

2025 Lilac Parade grand marshal

Mike Tonner, a resident of Lombard since 1960, was the grand marshal of this year's Lilac Parade, recognizing his decades of dedicated service to the community.
